

Coach, Parent and Player Code of Conduct



Young Athletes do not play any sport with the sole of intent to play professionally. They play because they enjoy the sport, want to have fun and make friends. Sometimes parents, coaches, spectators and even the players themselves do not realize that their actions, whether verbal or non-verbal may have a long-lasting effect on the athletes.

1. I will not force myself/my child to participate in sports.
2. I will remember that we participate to have fun and that the game is for the youth, not the adults.
3. I will be a positive role model for my peers/child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy.
4. I will not engage in any type of un-sportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent such as booing or taunting, refusing to shake hands or using profane language.
5. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well-being of the athletes.
6. I will teach my peers/child/player to play by the rules and resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
7. I will demand that my peers/child/player treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect.
8. I will teach my peers/child/player that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my peers/child/player will never feel defeated by outcome of the game or his/her performance.
9. I will praise my peers/child/player for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my peers/child/player feel like a winner every time.
10. I will never ridicule or yell at my peers/child/player or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
11. I will emphasize skill development and practice instead of winning. I will de-emphasize competition for children in lower levels.
12. I will respect game officials and their authority and will not confront coaches on the game field, but instead meet with them at an agreed upon time.
13. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games unless I am one of the official team coaches.






